### As parents / carers I/we undertake to: -

- Ensure that my son/daughter attends Newbridge regularly and any absences are notified appropriately e.g. telephone call to school and or letter to school.
  - Ensure that he/she wears the appropriate uniform at all times and support the action of Newbridge providing, as a temporary measure, 'spare' uniform in instances that are beyond my immediate control. I understand that this action would ensure that it is unnecessary to send him/her home to change.
  - Support the policies and guidelines on behaviour and equal opportunities. This includes the use of 'physical intervention', if and when it is necessary and appropriate to keep my son/daughter safe and or prevent injury to another person or damage property.
  - Understand that the pupil's programme needs to be flexible to support their individual needs (and in some cases avoid exclusion).
  - Wherever possible attend parent's evenings, annual review meetings and discussions about my child's progress.
  - Contact Newbridge via my Pupil and Family Partnership worker if I have any concerns / worries about my son/daughter or feel that I could be better supported
- Support the mobile phone/electronic device policy which states that misuse of devices could lead to confiscation.
