Flexible Learning & Timetabling

- **Flexible Scheduling:** Reduced or adjusted timetables for mornings, afternoons, or blended sessions to support wellbeing and focus.
- **Different Learning Spaces:** A mix of classroom, nurture, and specialised learning environments designed to promote comfort, focus, and independence.
- **Nurture Primary Model & Self-Directed Learning:** Students develop independence, curiosity, and ownership of their learning while pursuing subjects and activities that match their interests and passions.

Targeted Academic & Pastoral Support

- **1:1 and Small Group Support:** Targeted interventions delivered in small groups or individually to meet specific learning and pastoral needs.
- **Key Staff Support:** Students work closely with a small team of trusted adults, ensuring consistent support and meaningful relationships.
- **Targeted Booster Sessions:** Stretch and challenge our most able pupils through higher-order questioning, advanced problem-solving, analytical tasks, and preparation for higher-tier GCSE pathways to ensure sustained academic excellence.

- **Enrichment & Social Activities:** Timetables include opportunities for social interaction, wellbeing sessions, and enjoyable activities with significant adults to build confidence and connection.

Trusted staff provide targeted guidance, helping students rebuild confidence, strengthen relationships, and feel a renewed sense of belonging.


Personalised Pathways

Tailored Literacy and Numeracy Support

At Newbridge Learning Community, we are dedicated to helping your child reach their full potential. Our Reading, Literacy, and Numeracy support is tailored to each pupil, delivered in small groups or 1:1 sessions to meet individual needs.

Literacy support helps children build confidence through reading comprehension, phonics, vocabulary, and writing skills.

Numeracy support strengthens core number skills, problem-solving, reasoning, and exam preparation.

All sessions take place in a calm, structured environment designed to support your child's wellbeing, focus and resilience, helping them thrive both academically and emotionally.



Personalised Reading, Phonics & Comprehension Intervention



Building Confident, Independent Readers

Strong literacy is essential for success across the curriculum. Our Reading, Phonics, and Comprehension Programme ensures pupils develop secure reading skills, fluency, and comprehension strategies.

Why it matters:

Early intervention prevents gaps from widening and equips pupils with the skills to access all subjects. Pupils learn to decode, understand and engage confidently with texts.

Programme Focus:

- Systematic phonics teaching (letter-sound recognition, blending, segmenting)
- Decodable reading practice matched to ability
- Comprehension strategies: predicting, clarifying, questioning, summarising, inferring, and retrieving information
- Opportunities to discuss and explain texts to build reasoning and confidence

Impact: Pupils improve fluency, comprehension, and confidence, developing independence and a love of reading.



Numeracy Intervention - Building Confidence and Fluency in Mathematics

Our Numeracy Intervention Programme helps pupils strengthen core skills in number, calculation, problem-solving, and reasoning. Sessions are delivered in small groups and 1:1 to provide personalised support.



Why it matters:

Strong numeracy skills underpin learning across the curriculum. Targeted support ensures pupils master essential concepts, develop reasoning skills and approach mathematics with confidence.

Programme Focus:

- Core skills: number, place value, addition, subtraction, multiplication, division
- Fractions, decimals, percentages, and times tables fluency
- Problem-solving and reasoning
- Concrete, pictorial, and abstract approaches
- Step-by-step modelling, discussion, and explanation

Impact: Pupils gain accuracy, fluency, and confidence, enabling them to access all areas of learning successfully.
